Join SEWF and Glasgow Caledonian University (GCU) to focus on the role academia has to play in supporting social enterprise.

The Yunus Centre for Social Business and Health at GCU was founded in 2010 in honour of Noble Peace Prize winner Muhammad Yunus in recognition of his efforts to advance social and economic opportunities of disadvantaged people through micro-credit. Since then it become one of the world's leading centres for the study of social enterprise.

The university will host 100 academics and social enterprise practitioners from around the globe to look at what academia is doing internationally to advance social enterprise teaching, research and community engagement.

## BURSARIES

Thanks to the support of the Scottish Government and the Postcode Innovation Trust we can provide a bursary covering £200 of the price of the SEWF ticket for a number of social enterprises.

### IMPORTANT

- A fee of £49 + VAT is payable at the time of registration.
- The bursary provides access to the main SEWF event but does not include a provision towards accommodation, sustenance or any fringe or social events.
- We can only accept one application form per organisation and we cannot apply the bursary to registrations already purchased.

### CRITERIA

All applicants must be a social enterprise and meet at least two of these criteria:

- Annual income less than £200,000
- 10 employees or less
- Scottish applicants must have membership of a Social Enterprise Network (local or thematic) or be affiliated with an intermediary partner such as SENSCOT, CEMVO etc.
