We recognise the struggle to balance the positive social and environmental impact of bringing together social enterprises and their supporters throughout the world for in-person networking and discussion with the carbon footprint of international travel. As such, we are applying the strictest sustainable practices to our flagship annual forum as set out below.

The purchase of in person SEWF 2022 tickets include a mandatory carbon offset. We recognise that carbon offsets are not the sole solution to the environmental damage caused by air travel, but our scheme is part of a number of measures to address the impact of gathering people to collaborate to create a fairer global economy. These include encouraging digital participation and greening the event through waste reduction and other measures.
